SUMMARY OF WORK:

The Land Authority is looking at hiring (3) Fencing Laborers. The fence laborers will be removing and installing new fence to NRCS standards within the exterior boundaries of the Northern Cheyenne Indian Reservation. The employee is exposed to all weather and field conditions since all work is out doors.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Installs fence products as directed by the crew leader and/or Land Authority Director.

Operate various hand tools both powered and unpowered.

Cleans project site and yard area as directed.

Works with other members of the crew to complete assigned tasks.

Must be able to carry out written or oral instructions.

Must be able to operate ATV/UTV.
