**SUMMARY OF WORK:**

Responsible for operating a company service truck and driving to various locations to service/pump/clean portable restrooms or holding tanks. Hired individual will also be cross-trained as a propane technician to assist the propane truck driver during the off season of sanitation.

**JOB CHARACTERISTICS:**

**Nature of work:**

Morning Star Sanitation located in Lame Deer, MT is looking to hire a Sanitation Driver/Propane Technician. Our Sanitation Driver/Propane Technician will be responsible for driving a sanitation truck on specified routes to mechanically collect waste and transport it to appropriate disposal sites. Daily work will involve heavy industrial lifting, lifting waist high, gripping with hands, moving at a brisk consistent pace, and occasional bending. This position will also be responsible for safely, efficiently, and courteously serving customers. The position is Monday through Friday starting at 8:00AM ending at 5:00PM or when route is done. This position requires an open schedule for on-call and some weekends.

**Personal Contacts:** Position **requires** to have contact with the general public.

**Supervision Received:** General Supervision

**Essential Functions:** Incumbent **must** be able to

- Conduct daily pre-shift & post-shift vehicle inspection & report deficiencies to shop immediately. Also, report improper operation, faulty equipment, and unusual conditions to the Operations Supervisor/Manager.
- Operate service truck to and from pre-designated work sites based on daily routing information.
- Maintain telephone or radio contact with dispatch to receive additional instructions, changes to work locations, etc.
- Service portable restrooms, holding tanks, sinks, showers, etc., at various work sites by following the Company's servicing guidelines.
- Restock paper products, hand sanitizer, soap, etc. in units being serviced.
- Clean interior and exterior of units and add chemical solution to portable restroom units.
- Maintains truck logs according to state and federal regulations.
- Follow all established safety rules & regulations.
- Special/Other projects as assigned by management

**Physical Abilities:**
