SUMMARY OF WORK: This position coordinates bus runs, bus aide schedules, and bus maintenance. Requires moderate activity and adherence to the standards of operating a vehicle safely. This position drives bus in all weather conditions. The position may be required to work outside of normal working hours for on-call emergencies. Maintains confidentiality of sensitive information.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Knowledge: This position requires adequate mechanical skills for vehicle maintenance and emergency troubleshooting. Also, general knowledge of office practices and procedures, community knowledge, addresses, and safe bus driving practices.

Skills: This position requires skills in using a computer, copier, and fax machine. Also needs skills in scheduling and communicating with fellow employees and the public. Skills required in operating a bus safely and interacting with small children.

Abilities: This position requires the ability to: operate buses safely; adhere to standards of safety; keep accurate records; make decisions; implement guidelines; retain a positive attitude; communicate effectively orally and in writing; complete tasks in a competent and timely manner; follow verbal and written instruction; perform the moderate physical activity; be dependable; organize time wisely; work as part of a team; establish working relationships with fellow employees, supervisors, and the public.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:
