This document does <u>not</u> serve as a permit to engage in any of these activities. It is illegal to engage in any of these activities without the appropriate, lawful permits. To obtain a permit, please bring Tribal ID or Certificate of Indian Blood to Marissa Spang, Natural Resources Administrator, at the Department of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources. Permits for non-members are not granted at this time.

#### **BIG GAME**

Mule Deer (Antlered Only) ...... October 3 – December 3 (1 per member/season) White-tailed Deer (Antlered Only) ...... October 3 – December 3 (1 per member/season)

Only one deer permit (mule deer or whitetail) will be issued per member each season

Bison AUTHORIZED BY SPECIAL PERMIT ONLY
