**REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR  
MORELAND FENCING PROJECT**

The Northern Cheyenne Tribe is making Request for Proposals (RFP) to provide fencing service for the Morland property.

**Background and Objectives:**

The Moreland property is located South Southwest of Birney Mt. The property is owned by the Northern Cheyenne Tribe, primary use is for grazing. This property was acquired in the mid 70's it is located in Township 5 South and Range 41 East, having approximately 3,800 acres.

The location of the fence removal and replacement is as follows, Township 5 South Range 41 E section 26 South boundary, Section 34 East boundary. (See attached maps)

Following the Witten fire in 2017 the fire had destroyed approximately 4.18 miles of fence along the east, southeast and south boundaries was destroyed. This is scheduled for repair in the fall of 2017.

**Scope of Work:**

This proposal will require the removal and replacement of 22,100 total feet of barbed wire fence located on the upper and lower Moreland property. 19,600 feet will be to NRCS specifications and 2500 feet will be to BLM specifications. The proposed contractor will remove old wire and post, and replace the fence with new materials, this will be installed to NRCS and BLM specifications. The NRCS and BLM specifications for this fencing project are attached. The Land Authority will provide a dumpster on site to dispose of old wire and post that are unusable. Any unable post will be stockpiled and removed by the Land Authority office.

Contractor will supply equipment and materials needed to construct 4.18 miles of fence line, specification can be obtained from the land authority office.

Contractor will remove any burnt timber that may be a threat to the new fence.
